Eligibility: Any land real estate professional who intends to pursue the Accredited Land Consultant (ALC) Designation.

Considerations for selection:

- Membership in RLI
- Previous scholarships awarded, including any that have expired
- Required: A letter of recommendation from a current Realtors Land Institute member

Limitations:

- Only one scholarship per person per calendar year for a maximum award of \$535.
- Scholarships are prohibited from being used for a course that has already been paid for.
- Scholarships must be used within 12 months from date of approval.
- A lifetime maximum of two scholarships per RLI member and one scholarship per RLI nonmember.

Deadline: Applications should be submitted no later than the 15th of the month prior to the start of a new course.
