Scholarship Criteria

- 2. Must have successfully completed 1 required RLI class.
- 3. Must be actively involved in the real estate business focused primarily on land.
- 4. Applicants that are taking their first required RLI class will receive a special exception to item 1 & 2 of the criteria list as long as the broker or a member of the real estate firm help sponsor the Past Presidents Education Scholarship Fund.
